Introduction

Neath Port Talbot CVS has made this consultation document available on its website and through its general information services. Neath Port Talbot CVS welcomes the opportunity to respond to this consultation.

Response:

Neath Port Talbot CVS welcomes the requirement for a Voluntary Sector Non-Executive Director to be an employee or member of a voluntary sector organisation, however has some concerns regarding the move to broaden the eligibility criteria. It is important that the Voluntary Sector Non-Executive Director has an understanding of the Voluntary Sector in Wales and its contribution to public health. Given the intention to broaden the selection criteria, could it be reworded so that it reads as 'an employee or member of a voluntary sector organisation that serves Wales?'

This broadens the criteria as there will be individuals who aren't an employee or member of an organisation based in Wales, but they could be an employee or member of an organisation which serves Wales e.g. they may be part of a national organisation which provides services in Wales, but the organisation may not have a base in Wales.

Neath Port Talbot CVS agrees that given the proposed broadening of the eligibility criteria that successful candidates will need to demonstrate a knowledge and understanding of public health matters relevant to Wales.

In the Autumn of 2015 the Welsh Government conducted a high profile public consultation on a green paper Our Health Our Health Service. Part of this paper considered the governance of Trust and Health Boards in Wales and specifically considered the membership of the Boards of these organisations. One of the arguments put forward for altering the current statutory membership of these Boards was the desire for consistency between Trusts and Health Boards.

The Royal College of Nursing in Wales does not believe therefore that the timing and content of this proposal from Public Health Wales is. It is potentially confusing, and creates the impression that Public Health Wales is not aware of Welsh Government policy. This in

turn does not help to inspire confidence in the proposals.

The shortened timescale of 6 weeks public consultation (over the Christmas period) is likewise unhelpful if there is a genuine desire to engage with the sector.

The RCN is the world's largest professional union of nurses, representing over 430,000 nurses, midwives, health visitors and nursing students, including over 25,000 members in Wales. The majority of RCN members work in the NHS with around a quarter working in the independent sector. The RCN works locally, nationally and internationally to promote standards of care and the interests of patients and nurses, and of nursing as a profession. The RCN is a UK-wide organisation, with its own National Boards for Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. The RCN is a major contributor to nursing practice, standards of care, and public policy as it affects health and nursing.

One Voice Wales is recognised by the Welsh Government as the national representative body for community and town councils in Wales. It represents the sector on the Local Government Partnership Council and over three-quarters of the 735 community and town councils are already in membership, with numbers growing year on year. As well as our representative role, we also provide support and advice to councils on an individual basis and have previously launched, with Welsh Government support, a modular training programme for councillors, which continues to deliver effectively. We believe strongly that community councils are well-placed to develop the economic, social and environmental well-being of the areas they serve and, as such, are active and proactive in debating key issues such as energy policies, environmental issues and strategic planning. Our sector will support and wish to participate in the work and duties of the NHS Trust Board, and

it is hoped that our members will increasingly be enabled to do so with the changes brought about by these proposals. One Voice Wales would wish to point out that community and town councils are local authorities within their own right, and consequently their members may wish to be considered as appropriate candidates under the local authority non-executive category considered here. As individuals, of course, some members might also be potentially eligible under the other categories that are included.

Proposals to amend the Non-Executive Director eligibility criteria on the Public Health Wales NHS Trust Board

Dear Mr Barry,

I am writing on behalf of **BMA Cymru Wales** in response to the above consultation which is being conducted by the Welsh Government. We are grateful for being given an opportunity to comment on these proposals.

Whilst we will not be providing a comprehensive response to this consultation, and will not therefore be offering a view in relation to all the questions that have been posed, we would nonetheless like to make a couple of points for the Welsh Government's consideration.


Our key concern with what has been put forward is the proposal to remove the requirement for the University-Non Executive Director role-holder to have a teaching or research specialism in public health.

We feel this would send out the wrong message and give an impression, whether inadvertently or not, that the Welsh Government does not fully value public health. The proposal could also risk depriving the board of some genuine public health expertise – something we feel would be a retrograde step.

Our members also have some concerns about opening up posts to candidates from outside of Wales. We feel this would risk the possibility of having board members with insufficient knowledge and experience of Wales including of health, social care, environmental and educational matters. As a result, there could again be a risk of appointing board members who lack a degree of relevant knowledge or experience.

We trust that these views will be taken into account and given appropriate consideration prior to any final decisions being taken.
