



- 1. The lettering is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown
- 2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- 3. The colours are as follows: -

Background -Legend, border & arrow ----- Black

- 4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- 5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 6. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- 7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
- 8. Blind children (Plant dall) or Deaf children (Plant byddar) may replace Disabled children.
