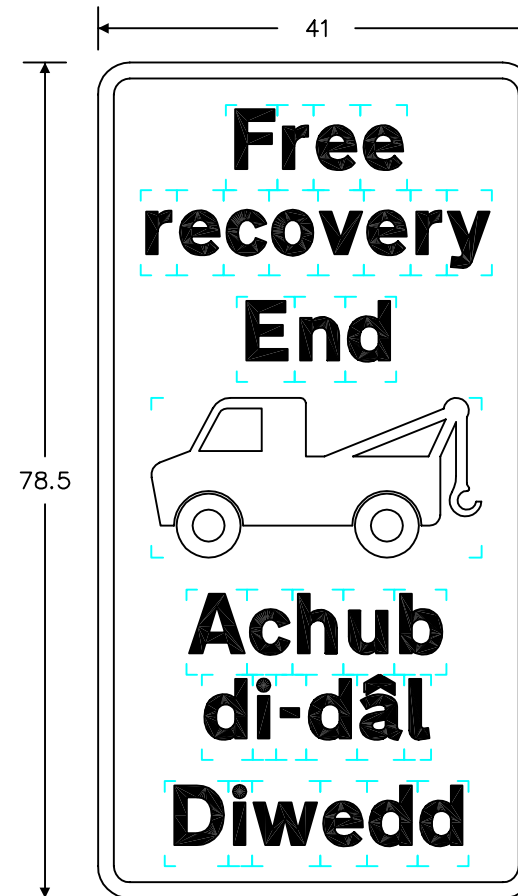


Notes:-

1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
2. Details of the recovery vehicle symbol are given on drawing no. S 63.
3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
4. The colours are as follows:-  
Border, legend and symbol \_\_\_\_\_ Black  
Background \_\_\_\_\_ Yellow
5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{height}$ ).
7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
