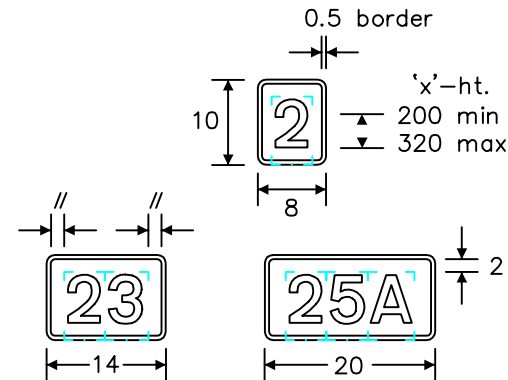


Notes: -

- The legends are from the Transport Medium and Motorway alphabets at the 'x'-heights shown.
- The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- The colours are as follows: -
  - Route symbol and border — White
  - Destination & mileage — White (Transport Medium alphabet)
  - Route number — White (Motorway alphabet)
  - Background — Blue
  - Junction no. patch: -
    - Background — Black
    - Border — White
    - Number — White (Transport Medium alphabet)
- The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4x'$ -height).
- The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- The order of languages may be reversed if required.



These dimensions are in stroke widths based on the 'x'-height of the junction number which is 80% of the main 'x'-height.
