- 2. Details of the 'P' and motorcycle symbols are given on drawings S43 & S23.
- 3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- 4. The colours are as follows:—

 Background & 'P' symbol White

 Legend, border,
 route symbol and motorcycle Black
 'P' symbol tile Blue
- 5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 6. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
- 7. See Chapter 7 of the Traffic Signs Manual for further design guidance. The width of each route arm is related to the status of the route indicated; 6sw for primary routes, 4sw for numbered non-primary routes (the route number is not shown on the sign) and 2.5sw for unnumbered non-primary routes. When the sign is situated on a primary route the colours remain as indicated in note 4 above (the sign does not have a green background). The sign shall be used to indicate parking places only; no other destinations shall be shown. The map-type route symbol shall be varied to accord with the junction layout.
