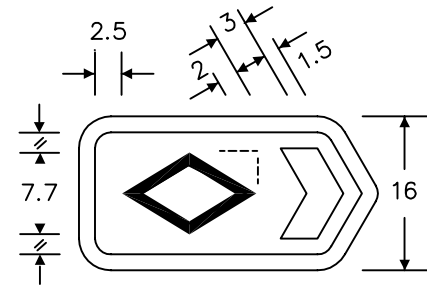


- Notes: -
1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
 2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
 3. The colours are as follows: -
 Legend, chevron, symbol & border ——— Black
 Background ——— Yellow
 4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
 5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are in stroke widths (i.e. $1s/w = 1/4x'$ -height). The range of sizes for the symbolic diversion route sign is based on a minimum 'x'-height of 50mm and maximum 'x'-height of 200mm.
 6. Drawing P 56 (sheet 1) shows details of the diversion route symbol and other symbols that may be used.
 7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
 8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.



Variant
Symbolic Diversion Route

The width of the chevron is determined from the overall height of the sign and shall take the value as shown in the table below.

HEIGHT OF SIGN H sw	WIDTH OF CHEVRON W sw
to <19	3
19 to <27	4
27 to <35	5
35 to <43	6
43 to <51	7
51 to <59	8

Where the height exceeds 59sw it is recommended that two or more smaller signs are used.
