
Notes: -

- 1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
- 2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- 4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- 5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are in stroke widths (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 6. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- 7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.



The width of the chevron is determined from the overall height of the sign and shall take the value as shown in the table below.
