


- 1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
- 2. Details of the Telephone symbol are given on drawing S 41.
- 3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- 4. The colours are as follows:—
 Background White
 Border, legend,
 chevron & telephone Black
- 5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths based on the numeral 'x'-height. (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- 8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
