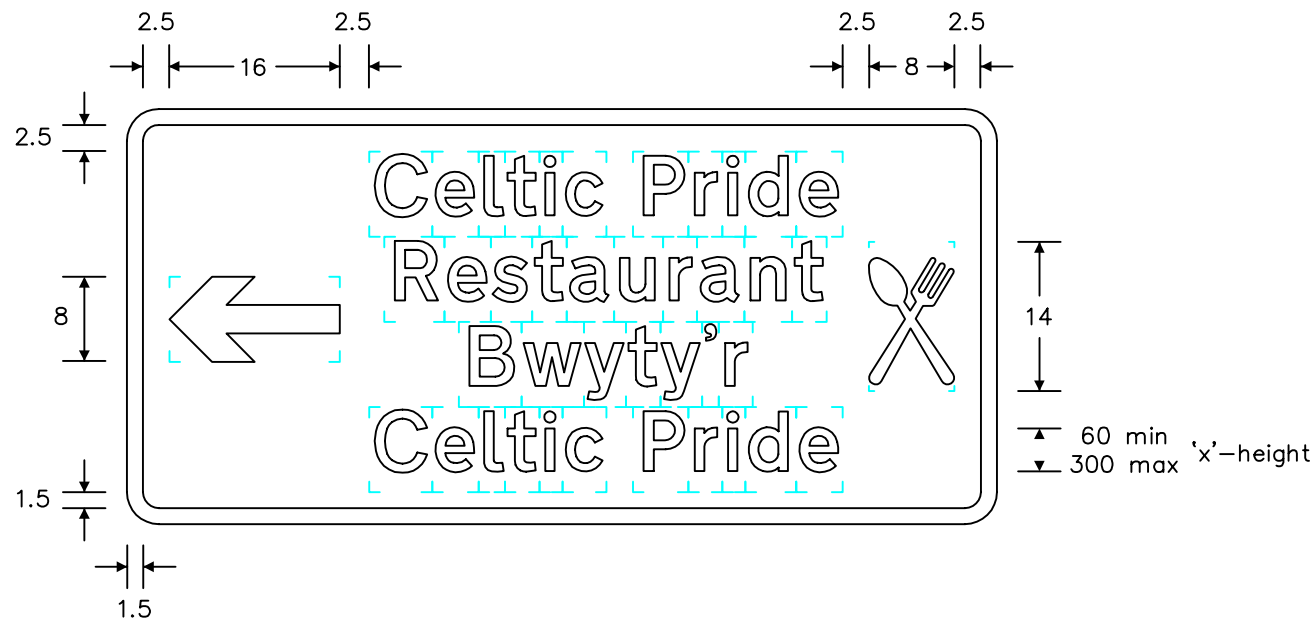


Notes:-

1. The legend is from the Transport Medium alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
2. The colours are as follows:-
Background ——— Brown
Border, legend, symbol and arrow ——— White
3. Details of the 'Spoon and fork' symbol are given on Drwg. No. S 46.
4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
6. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
