OVERVIEW OF UK HOUSING & PLANNING STATISTICS


The decentralised nature of the UK housing and planning system means that different organisations produce statistics about different aspects of housing. This overview of housing and planning statistics shows which areas of statistics are produced by government departments, devolved administrations and some arm's length bodies, as well those produced by the Office for National Statistics. For simplicity this overview separates housing topics into the broad themes of demand, supply and stock, although in reality some topics relate to multiple themes.
