THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (VARIOUS ROADS, CORWEN, CLWYD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1995

MADE

25th September 1995

COMING INTO FORCE 7th Octobel 1995

The Secretary of State for Wales as traffic authority for the relevant length of the London-Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the North Wales Police hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 14th October 1995 and may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Various Roads, Corwen, Clwyd) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 199 .
- 2. (1) In this Order, "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and
 - (2) For the purpose of this Order, a vehicle displays:
 - (i) a disabled person's badge issued before 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position, if -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;
 - (ii) a disabled person's badge issued on or after 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or

- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (iii) a parking disc in the relevant position if -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in article 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.
- 4. Save as provided in article 6 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm from 1st April until 30th September (both days inclusive) on the length and sides of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- 5. Save as provided in article 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on the sides of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3:-
 - (a) for a longer period than 40 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road.
- 6. (1) Nothing in articles 3, 4 and 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths or on the sides of the trunk road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
 - (a) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (b) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;



- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths and sides of the trunk road; or
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said lengths and sides of the trunk road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984(a);
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- (e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths or on the sides of the trunk road referred to therein for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length or side of the trunk road on the same day).
- (3) Nothing in article 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on the sides of the trunk road referred to therein.
- 7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 8. The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Corwen) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1967 (b) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULES (All distances are approximate)

Lengths and sides of the trunk road at Corwen in the County of Clwyd

SCHEDULE 1

NO WAITING BETWEEN 09.00 HRS AND 18.00 HRS

- 1. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 149 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Penybryn Road, in a general westerly direction for a distance of 250 metres.
- 2. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 51 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Penybryn Road to a point 52 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Green Lane, a distance of 175 metres.
- 3. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 32 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Brook Side to a point 55 metres east of the centrepoint of the said junction, a distance of 87 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

NO WAITING BETWEEN 09.00 HRS AND 18.00 HRS BETWEEN 1ST APRIL AND 30TH SEPTEMBER

- 1. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 149 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Penybryn Road to a point 51 metres west of the centrepoint of the said junction, a distance of 98 metres.
- 2. The northern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 52 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Green Lane to a point 32 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Brook Side, a distance of 179 metres.
- 3. The southern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 52 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Green Lane to a point 8 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Aber View, a distance of 79 metres.
- 4. The southern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 54 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Aber View to a point 50 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Brook Side, a distance of 36 metres.



SCHEDULE 3

WAITING BETWEEN 09.00 HRS AND 18.00 HRS RESTRICTED TO 40 MINS IN ANY PERIOD OF 2 HRS

- 1. The southern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 8 metres east of the centrepoint of its junction with Aber View to a point 54 metres east of the centrepoint of the said junction, a distance of 46 metres.
- 2. The southern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 50 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with Brook Side to a point 32 metres west of the centrepoint of the said junction, a distance of 18 metres.
