1. Daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 24 Mawrth 2017 a'i enw yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A489 (Newtown Road, Machynlleth, Powys) (Terfyn Cyflymder 30 mya a Therfyn Cyflymder 20 mya Rhan-amser) 2017.

2.—(1) Yn y Gorchymyn hwn:

ystyr “cerbyd esempt” (“*exempted vehicle*”) yw:

(a) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio gan y gwasanaethau brys at y dibenion a ddisgrifir yn adran 87 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrrdd 1984(2);

The A489 Trunk Road (Newtown Road, Machynlleth, Powys) (30 mph & Part-time 20 mph Speed Limits) Order 2017

Made 21 March 2017

Coming into force 24 March 2017

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Caersws – Machynlleth Trunk Road (A489) (“the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 84(1), (1A) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Dyfed-Powys Police, make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 24 March 2017 and its title is The A489 Trunk Road (Newtown Road, Machynlleth, Powys) (30 mph & Part-time 20 mph Speed Limits) Order 2017.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

(a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(2);

(1) 1984 c.27; section 84(1) was substituted by the Road Traffic Act 1991 (c.40), section 45(2). Section 84(2) was substituted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 61. By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

(2) 1984 c.27; Section 87 was amended by the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 (c.21), Schedule 1, paragraph 55, the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act 2005 (c. 15), Schedule 4, paragraph 42, the Crime and Courts Act 2013 (c. 22), Schedule 8, paragraph 29(2) and the Deregulation Act 2015 (c. 20), section 50(4) and (5).

(b) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at ddibenion y llynges, y fyddin neu'r llu awyr ac sy'n cael ei yrru gan berson sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i orchymnon aelod o luoedd arfog y Goron, sy'n aelod o'r luoedd arbennig—

- (i) ac sydd wedi ei hyfforddi i yrru ar gyflymderau uchel ac sy'n gweithredu wrth ymateb, neu wrth ymarfer ymateb, i argyfwng diogelwch gwladol; neu
- (ii) at ddiben hyfforddi person i yrru cerbydau ar gyflymderau uchel;

ystyr “lluoedd arbennig” (“*special forces*”) yw'r unedau hynny o'r luoedd cartref y mae Cyfarwyddwr y Lluoedd Arbennig yn gyfrifol am gynnal eu galluoedd neu sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i reolaeth weithredol y Cyfarwyddwr hwnnw.

(2) Mae unrhyw gyfeiriad yn y Gorchymyn hwn at erthygl neu Atodlen â rhif yn gyfeiriad at yr erthygl neu'r Atodlen sy'n dwyn y rhif hwnnw yn y Gorchymyn hwn.

Cyfyngiadau

3. Ni chaiff neb yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur, ac eithrio cerbyd esempt, yn gyflymach nag 20 milltir yr awr ar y darn o'r gefnffordd a bennir yn Atodlen 1.

4. Ni chaiff neb yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur, ac eithrio cerbyd esempt, yn gyflymach na 30 milltir yr awr ar y darn o'r gefnffordd a bennir yn Atodlen 2.

Cymhwysyo

5. Nid yw'r cyfyngiadau yn erthyglau 3 a 4 yn gymwys ond ar yr adegau hynny ac i'r graddau hynny y bydd arwyddion traffig yn eu dangos.

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—

- (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
- (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“*lluoedd arbennig*”) means those units of the home forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions

3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

Application

5. The restrictions in articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

**THE A489 TRUNK ROAD (NEWTOWN ROAD,
MACHYNLETH, POWYS) (30 MPH & PART-
TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2017**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under section 84(1), (1A) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 24 March 2017.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a part-time 20 mph speed limit on the length of the A489 trunk road described in Schedule 1 to this Notice in order to reduce the speed of traffic and promote pedestrian safety near Ysgol Bro Hyddgen at Machynlleth, Powys. The extent of the existing 30 mph speed limit on the A489 trunk road described in Schedule 2 will also be extended. The part-time 20 mph speed limit is only expected to apply for limited periods of the day during school term time: at all other times the existing 30 mph speed limit will be in force.
