Title, Commencement and Interpretation

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“*lloedd arbennig*”) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director; and

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road.

Restrictions

3. No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road described in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road described in Schedule 2 to this Order.

5. No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road described in Schedule 3 to this Order.

6. The restriction in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed Order is necessary to ensure the safety of the public in connection with pedestrian movements near Aberaeron Primary School and to safeguard road users on the A487 trunk road at Aberaeron, Ceredigion.

The purpose of the Order is to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on a length of the A487 trunk road to reduce the speed of traffic near the school when school pupils are travelling to and from the school site. The 20 mph speed limit is intended to operate for limited periods of the day during school term time when indicated by traffic signs: at all other times the existing 30 mph speed limit will remain in force. The reduced speed limit during these periods is intended to reduce the likelihood of a collision and promote pedestrian safety.

The Order will also introduce a 20 mph speed limit on a length of the A487 trunk road in Aberaeron town centre. Investigations have shown that existing traffic speeds in the centre of the town warrant a 20 mph speed limit as recent evidence indicates all recorded collisions were located along this length of the A487 trunk road.

A 40 mph speed limit will also be introduced on a length of the A487 trunk road on the northbound approach to the school that is currently subject to the national speed limit. This will reduce the speed of approaching traffic in the vicinity of the school at all times and will create a buffer zone between the 60 mph and 20 mph speed limits, which will safeguard all road users.

The Welsh Ministers propose to make an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 84(1)(a), 84(1)(c), (1A) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the length of the A487 trunk road described in Schedule 1 to this Notice. The 20 mph speed limit is intended to apply for limited periods of the day during school term time when indicated by traffic signs; at all other times the existing 30 mph speed limit will remain in force. The reduced speed limit during these periods is intended to reduce the speed of traffic and promote pedestrian safety near Aberaeron Primary School at Aberaeron, Ceredigion.

A 20 mph speed limit will also be introduced on the length of the A487 trunk road described in Schedule 2 to this Notice. Investigations have shown that existing traffic speeds in the centre of the town warrant a 20 mph speed limit as recent evidence indicates all recorded collisions were located along this length of the A487 trunk road.

A 40 mph speed limit will also be imposed on the length of the A487 trunk road described in Schedule 3 to this Notice. This will reduce the speed of traffic on the northbound approach to the school and will create a buffer zone between the 60 mph and 20 mph speed limits, which will safeguard all road users.
