ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROAD (LLANRHYSTYD, DYFED) (RESTRICTED ROADS AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1978

MADE 20th October 1978

COMING INTO OPERATION 15th November 1978

The Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 72(3), 73(1), 74(1) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Constabulary, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th November 1978 and may be cited as the Trunk Road (Llanrhystyd, Dyfed) (Restricted Roads and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1978.
2. (1) In this Order "the trunk road" means the Fishguard - Aberystwyth - Dolgelly - Caernarvon - Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A487).
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament, and the directions revoked by Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
3. The direction in the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (No 16) Order 1964(d) which by virtue of section 110(2) of and paragraphs 1 and 5 of Schedule 8 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 has effect as if made by the Secretary of State and as if it were a direction that the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is to become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the said Act of 1967, is hereby revoked.
4. The direction in the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Wales) (No 1) Order 1968(e) which directs that the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order is to become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the said Act of 1967, is hereby revoked.

5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order..
6. The length of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.

SCHEDULE 1

That length of the trunk road, at Llanrhystyd in the County of Dyfed, which extends from a point 150 yards north of its junction with the Llanrhystyd - Llanybydder road (B4337) to a point 466 yards south-west of that junction, a distance of 616 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the trunk road, at Llanrhystyd in the County of Dyfed, which extends from a point 200 yards south-west of its junction with the road known as Glanyrafon Terrace to a point 456 yards south-west of that junction, a distance of 256 yards.

SCHEDULE 3

Lengths of the trunk road at Llanrhystyd in the County of Dyfed:-

1. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 456 yards south-west of its junction with Glanyrafon Terrace in a general north-easterly direction for a distance of 600 yards.
2. That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 153 yards north of its junction with the Llanrhystyd - Llanybydder road (B4337) in a general north-easterly direction to a point 84 yards north-east of its junction with the County Class III Road (C1127) leading to Llanrhystyd School, a distance of approximately 357 yards.



SCHEDULE 4

That length of the trunk road, at Llanrhystyd in the County of Dyfed, which extends from a point 153 yards north of its junction with the Llanrhystyd - Llanybydder road (B4337) in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 280 yards.
