

What is the census rehearsal?

census

- Census rehearsal day is the 13th October 2019
- Four rehearsal areas, Tower Hamlets, Hackney, Ceredigion,
 Carlisle
- Chosen because they present a good cross section of society and incorporate diverse communities.
- Households will receive an invitation to complete their questionnaire online
- A mini-census, an end-to-end test of just about everything we will need to do for the real thing in 2021







Ceredigion rehearsal - media


- Targeted messages in stories of local interest

- Includes publications in Welsh, agricultural outlets and charitable organisations to reach all areas of the local demographic



Ceredigion rehearsal: Our engagement

ONS is working well with Ceredigion local authority - e.g. LA promoted census field jobs, provided information on communities and areas. The census team has also presented plans to Ceredigion Council Members - great support for the rehearsal from the Leader of the Council and the members.



- We shared plans for activities going to take place in Ceredigion with Ben Lake, MP Ceredigion at the event we attended in Parliament (Evidence Week – June 2019)
- The Census Engagement Manager (CEM) is working in Ceredigion to raise awareness of the census, build relationships
 - Making great contacts within Ceredigion with plenty of offers of support (promoting the census, providing venues for events etc).
 - Met organisations representing the community, disability groups and Veterans. Met with University of the Third Age based in Cardigan as well as Coleg Ceredigion, attended Royal Welsh Show to promote the census rehearsal taking place in Ceredigion and field staff job opportunities, attended Aberystwyth student union & freshers fair, met Young Farmers, attended Youth Council Forum, attended Equality and Disabilities Forum, attended Cardigan County Agricultural Show
 - Partnerships that have been developed are already delivering fantastic insights such as areas of digital exclusion, offers of support to run completion events within community locations and to communicate the importance of the census through their channels.



Census engagement



Engagement in Wales for 2021 Census



- We have asked LAs to nominate a Census Liaison Manager and Assistant Census Liaison Manager. 100% of Welsh LAs have at least one of these in place (less than 90% in England).
- We ran a series of Roadshows earlier in 2019 to raise awareness of the census including one
 in Wrexham.
- 2021 Census community engagement activities Partnerships team has met with number
 of organisations, charities etc in Wales to raise awareness of the census and to encourage
 support. Engagement also providing great insight to feed back to programme. Organisations
 we've met with include: Cymorth Cymru, Shelter Cymru, Age Cymru, EYST, The Wallich,
 Wales Housing Network, Tai Pawb, Race Council Cymru, Romani Cultural & Arts Company.
 We're about to meet organisations that represent the interests of BAME communities in Wales
 (e.g. Muslim Council of Wales) and accessibility groups in Wales.
