1.—(1) Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cau Priffyrdd (Tir wrth Gyffordd Chepstow Road a Livingstone Place, Maendy, Casnewydd) 202- a daw i rym ar \*\*\*\*\* 202-.

(2) Yn y Gorchymyn hwn—

ystyr “y Cyngor” (“*the Council*”) yw Cyngor Dinas Casnewydd;

ystyr “y datblygwr” (“*the developer*”) yw'r person sy'n gwneud y datblygiad y mae'r caniatâd cynllunio wedi ei roi ar ei gyfer;

ystyr “Deddf 1990” (“*the 1990 Act*”) yw Deddf Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1990; ac

ystyr “y plan a adnewwyd” (“*the deposited plan*”) yw'r plan sy'n dwyn yr enw “Gorchymyn Cau Priffyrdd (Tir wrth Gyffordd Chepstow Road a Livingstone Place, Maendy, Casnewydd) 202-” sy'n dod gyda'r Gorchymyn hwn.

**Cau Priffordd**

2. Yn ddarostyngedig i erthyglau 3, 4 a 5 o'r Gorchymyn hwn mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn awdurdodi cau'r darn o briffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Gorchymyn hwn. Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi eu bodloni bod angen cau'r briffordd er mwyn gwneud y datblygiad yn unol â'r caniatâd cynllunio a roddwyd o dan Ran 3 o Ddeddf 1990 gan y Cyngor ar 29 Mawrth 2018 o dan y cyfeirnod 17/1111 ac a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of their powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990(1), make this Order.

**Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Stopping Up of Highways (Land At The Junction Of Chepstow Road And Livingstone Place, Maindee, Newport) Order 202- and it comes into force on \*\*\*\*\* 202-.

(2) In this Order—

“the Council” (“*y Cyngor*”) means Newport City Council;

“the deposited plan” (“*y plan a adnewwyd*”) means the plan entitled “The Stopping Up of Highways (Land At The Junction Of Chepstow Road And Livingstone Place, Maindee, Newport) Order 202-” which accompanies this Order;

“the developer” (“*y datblygwr*”) means the person carrying out the development for which the planning permission has been granted; and

“the 1990 Act” (“*Deddf 1990*”) means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

**Stopping Up**

2. Subject to articles 3, 4, and 5 of this Order the Welsh Ministers authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order. The Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the stopping up is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part 3 of the 1990 Act by the Council on 29 March 2018 with reference number 17/1111 and described in Schedule 2 to this Order.

(1) 1990 c. 8 section 247 was amended by section 20(4) of, and paragraph 24 of Schedule 6 to, the Local Government (Wales) Act 1994 (c 19). By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

## **Y Darpariaethau sy'n Angenrheidiol neu'n Hwylus cyn Cau Priffordd**

**3.** Ni chaniateir cau'r darn o briffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Gorchymyn hwn—

- (a) hyd nes y bydd y datblygwr wedi darparu, er boddhad rhesymol y Cyngor, blaniau sy'n dangos sut y mae'r darn o briffordd i'w gau;
- (b) hyd nes y bydd y datblygiad a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn wedi ei ddechrau a bod y datblygwr wedi hysbysu'r Cyngor yn ysgrifenedig ei bod yn angenrheidiol cau'r darn o briffordd er mwyn i'r datblygiad fynd rhagddo; ac
- (c) hyd nes y bydd y Cyngor wedi ysgrifennu at y datblygwr i gadarnhau bod paragraffau (a) a (b) wedi eu bodloni.

## **Ymgwymerwyr Statudol a Darparwyr**

**4.** Pan fo gan ymgwymerwyr statudol neu ddarparwyr system gyfathrebu gyhoeddus unrhyw gyfarpar o dan y briffordd, ynddi, arni, drosti, ar ei hyd neu ar ei thraws yn union cyn cau'r darn o briffordd yna (yn ddarostyngedig i adran 261(4) o Ddeddf 1990), bydd gan yr ymgwymerwyr neu'r darparwyr yr un hawliau mewn cysylltiad â'r cyfarpar ag a oedd ganddynt cyn cau'r briffordd.

## **Cyfnod Para'r Gorchymyn hwn**

**5.** Os na fydd y datblygiad a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn wedi ei ddechrau yn y cyfnod perthnasol a bennir yn Rhan 3 o Ddeddf 1990 fel cyfnod para'r caniatâd cynllunio, neu os caiff y caniatâd ei ddirymu cyn diwedd y cyfnod hwnnw, bydd y Gorchymyn hwn yn peidio â chael effaith pan ddaw'r caniatâd cynllunio i ben.

Llofnodwyd o dan awdurdod Gweinidog yr Economi, Trafnidiaeth a Gogledd Cymru, un o Weinidogion Cymru.

## **Provisions Necessary or Expedient before Stopping Up**

**3.** The length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order must not be stopped up until—

- (a) the developer has provided, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council, plans showing how the length of highway is to be stopped up;
- (b) the development described in Schedule 2 to this Order has commenced and the developer has informed the Council in writing of the necessity to stop up the length of highway to allow the development to proceed; and
- (c) the Council has confirmed in writing to the developer that paragraphs (a), and (b) are satisfied.

## **Statutory Undertakers and Providers**

**4.** Where immediately before the length of highway is stopped up, there is under, in, on, over, along or across the highway any apparatus of statutory undertakers or public communications providers then (subject to section 261(4) of the 1990 Act) the undertakers or providers continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they had before the stopping up.

## **Duration of this Order**

**5.** If the development described in Schedule 2 to this Order has not begun within the relevant period specified in Part 3 of the 1990 Act as being the duration of the planning permission, or the permission is revoked before the end of that period, this Order ceases to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission.

Ailwampio adeilad cyfleusterau cyhoeddus presennol gan gynnwys newidiadau i ymyl y to a newid defnydd i gaffi A3 man cymunedol, codi wal ddringo, cerflun cyhoeddus ac offer chwarae ac addasu gardd gymunedol bresennol a gwaith tirlunio cysylltiedig.

**SCHEDULE 1**  
**Length of highway to be stopped up**  
**(All measurements are approximate)**

An irregular shaped length of highway located between Chepstow Road and Livingstone Place, Maendee, Newport having a total area of 55 square metres and shown as zebra hatching on the deposited plan.

**SCHEDULE 2**  
**The Development**

Refurbishment of existing public convenience building including alterations to roof edge and change of use to A3 cafe and community space, erection of climbing wall, public sculpture and play equipment and modification to existing community garden and associated landscaping.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 247 o Ddeddf Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1990 (“Deddf 1990”) i awdurdodi cau’r darn o briffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i’r Hysbysiad hwn. Nid awdurdodir cau’r briffordd ond er mwyn gwneud y datblygiad yn unol â’r caniatâd cynllunio a roddwyd o dan Ran 3 o Ddeddf 1990 gan Gyngor Dinas Casnewydd ar 29 Mawrth 2018 o dan y cyfeirnod 17/1111 ac a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i’r Hysbysiad hwn.

Bydd Gorchymyn Cau Priffyrdd (Tir wrth Gyffordd Chepstow Road a Livingstone Place, Maendy, Casnewydd) 202- (“y Gorchymyn”), os caiff ei wneud, yn peidio â chael effaith os daw’r caniatâd cynllunio ar gyfer y datblygiad i ben neu os caiff ei ddirymu.

Os ydych yn dymuno gwrthwynebu, cefnogi neu gyflwyno sylwadau, efallai y bydd angen i Lywodraeth Cymru ymgynghori â phobl a sefydliadau y tu allan i Lywodraeth Cymru. Fel rhan o’r broses ymgynghori, bydd yr wybodaeth yr ydych wedi ei rhoi a’ch data personol yn cael eu trosglwyddo i’r ceisydd/datblygwr ac, os oes angen, i’r awdurdod priffyrdd lleol i’w galluogi hwy i ymateb i chi. ## **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

### **THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (LAND AT THE JUNCTION OF CHEPSTOW ROAD AND LIVINGSTONE PLACE, MAINDEE, NEWPORT) ORDER 202-**

The Welsh Ministers propose to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (“the 1990 Act”) to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Notice. The stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable the development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part 3 of the 1990 Act by Newport City Council on 29 March 2018 with reference number 17/1111 described in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

The Stopping Up of Highways (Land At The Junction Of Chepstow Road And Livingstone Place, Maindee, Newport) Order 202- (“the Order”), if made, will cease to have effect if planning permission in respect of the development expires or is revoked.

During 28 days from 18 January 2021 copies of the draft Order and the deposited plan may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours at Maindee Library, 79 Chepstow Road, Newport, NP19 8BY or may be obtained free of charge from the address below quoting reference qA1443494.

Objections, specifying the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to Orders Branch, Transport, Welsh Government, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ or by email to [TransportOrdersBranch@gov.wales](mailto:TransportOrdersBranch@gov.wales) by 15 February 2021.

Should you wish to object, support or make representations, the Welsh Government may need to consult with persons and organisations outside the Welsh Government. As part of the consultation process, the information you have provided and your personal data will be passed to the applicant/developer and, if necessary, to the local highway authority to enable them to respond to you. The Welsh Government will only disclose your personal details where it is necessary to do so to address the issues raised. Where objections cannot be resolved and the Order becomes subject to a Public Inquiry (“PI”), all correspondence is copied to the Inspector of the PI and is available in the PI library when it becomes publicly available.

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
