Made 09 March 2021

Coming into force 10 March 2021

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 45, and 203(9) and (10) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006⁽¹⁾, and after consulting in accordance with section 45(4) of that Act with the bodies appearing to them to be representative of persons to whose remuneration these Directions relate, give the following Directions.

Title, application and commencement

1.—(1) The title of these Directions is the National Health Service (General Medical Services – Premises Costs) (Wales) (Amendment) Directions 2021.

(2) These Directions are given to Local Health Boards.

(3) These Directions come into force on 10 March 2021.

(Wales) Directions 2015**

2.—(1) The National Health Service (General Medical Services – Premises Costs) (Wales) Directions 2015⁽²⁾ are amended as follows.

(2) For direction 41A substitute—

(1) 2006 c. 42.
(2) 2015 No. 9.

“Notional rent review assessments between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2022

41A. A review assessment of the contractor’s notional rent by a LHB, as required by direction 41, which takes place in the period beginning with 1 April 2020 and ending with 31 March 2022 must be undertaken and determined in accordance with Parts 1 and 4 of Schedule 2.”.

(3) In Schedule 2 Part 4 in the part heading, for “2021” substitute “2022”.

Amendment to the National Health Service (General Medical Services – Premises Costs) (Wales) (Amendment) Directions 2020

3. In the National Health Service (General Medical Services – Premises Costs) (Wales) (Amendment) Directions 2020(1) omit direction 2(2).
