Thank you for your request which I received on 13 March 2021. You asked the following information (with the names of all victims redacted):

- A) All complaints of statutory rape.
- B) All complaints detailing "outing" or breaches of s22 of the gender recognition act 2004.
- C) All other complaints of sexual misconduct.
- D) All complaints of sexual assault.
- E) All complaints of unwanted contact.

raised by any female or transgender female member of the public against any male or transgender male member of the service between 1/1/2010 - 1/1/2020. Please exclude any complaints raised by myself if any exist.

You subsequently requested that only the details of the male accused if the accusation against them has been proven true within a criminal court of law in the United Kingdom and has not been overturned by a higher tier of fact.

I can confirm there have been no cases.
