## ATISN 14999 – COVID in gyms

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 19 February. You asked for –

- 1. A copy of the scientific evidence that supported the First Minister's statement of 18 February regarding the COVID-19 transmission risks associated with opening gyms in Wales.
- 2. Data/evidence that proves community spread of any variant of Coronavirus within gyms in Wales, also with supporting evidence/ genome sequencing to demonstrate positive test results for variant B.1.1.7 directly linked to community spread in gyms in Wales.
- 3. What financial package is in place to support this forced prolonged shutdown.

## Our Response

On Q1/2, the Technical Advisory Cell (TAC) provides scientific and technical advice to support Ministers' to make informed decisions about the risk of transmission. In January, the TAC published a paper that identified the potential routes and risks of transmission, as well as any potential measures which can be taken to help reduce risks associated with activities in indoor exercise facilities in general (i.e. not just indoor gyms). The Welsh government is continuously reviewing evidence and risk as the course of the epidemic changes, and the Coronavirus Control plan in Wales does include the relaxation of restrictions on gyms in the near future.
