ATISN 15045 - Postal Prescriptions

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 1 April. You requested information relating to the Royal Mail delivering prescription medicine to those categorised as clinically vulnerable, specifically:

- 1. The number of prescriptions delivered by the Royal Mail to those who were categorised as clinically vulnerable and told to stay at home and 'shield' during the first wave of the pandemic between April and June 2020.
- 2. The cost to have the Royal Mail deliver prescription medicine to clinically vulnerable people on the shielding list between April and June 2020.

Our response

Between the period April to June 2020 Royal Mail delivered 514 prescriptions to those who were categorised as clinically vulnerable and told to stay at home and 'shield'. This cost a total of £1,693 for Royal Mail to provide this service. A breakdown of this data can be found in the table below:
