ATISN 15047: Swimming Pools

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 1 April. You requested information related to Covid 19 evidence used by Welsh Government specifically:

 To provide the evidence that the Welsh Government is using to show that swimming pools are unsafe and should remain closed to reduce the risk of spreading Covid 19.

Our Response

The information you have requested has been published and can be located on the Welsh Government's website using the following link:

The Welsh Government is continuously reviewing the evidence and risk as the course of the epidemic changes, and the Coronavirus relaxation plan in Wales does include the relaxation of restrictions on outdoor and indoor swimming pools in the near future.

Next Steps

The request you sent me contains personal information about you - for example, your name and address. The Welsh Government will be the data processor for this information and, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, it will be processed in order to fulfil our public task and meet our legal obligations under the Act to provide you with a response.

We will only use this personal information to deal with your request and any matters which arise as a result of it. We will keep your personal information and all other information relating to your request for three years from the date on which your request is finally closed. Your personal information will then be disposed of securely.

Under data protection legislation, you have the right:

to be informed of the personal data we hold about you and to access it



- to require us to rectify inaccuracies in that data
- to (in certain circumstances) object to or restrict processing
- for (in certain circumstances) your data to be 'erased'
- to (in certain circumstances) data portability
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) who is our independent regulator for data protection
