The request

Thank you for your request which I received on 9 April 2021. You asked for the following information:

The figure of deaths in Wales for the period of 3/3/2020 till 1/2/2021 of citizens whom have died solely of COVID-19 with no whatsoever underlying conditions.

Welsh Government do not hold this information.

The Office for National Statistics (ONS) collect and produce mortality statistics for England and Wales based on information collected during the death registration process. They publish quarterly information on the number of <u>pre-existing conditions</u> of people who died due to COVID-19 (i.e. where Covid-19 was identified as the underlying (main) cause on the death certificate).


