Thank you for your request which I received on 9 April 2021. You asked for the following information:

the number of people who have died in Wales from any cause (all cause mortality) within 28 days of receiving either the first and/or second dose of any manufacturer's "covid vaccine" between 1st December 2020 to 31st March 2021.

I can confirm Welsh Government does not hold this information. The Office for National Statistics (ONS) collect and produce mortality statistics for England and Wales based on information from the death registration process and vaccinations data is collected by Public Health Wales. You may wish to contact Public Health Wales at <u>foi.phw@wales.nhs.uk</u>, as they may hold this information.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
