The A5 Trunk Road (West of Llangollen, Denbighshire) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A5 trunk road, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84(1)(a), (2) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of North Wales Police and given public notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(2).

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A5 Trunk Road (West of Llangollen, Denbighshire) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 202- and this Order comes into force on **** 202-.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“*lluoedd arbennig*”) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A5 London to Holyhead trunk road.

Restriction

3. No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road that extends from a point 231 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the B5103 at Berwyn, west of Llangollen, Denbighshire to a point 1,537 metres east of the centre-point of that junction.

Revocation

4. The A5 Trunk Road (Berwyn Road, Llangollen, Denbighshire) (De-Restriction) Order 2002(2) is revoked.

**THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (WEST OF
LLANGOLLEN, DENBIGHSHIRE) (40 MPH
SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202-**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed Order is required to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on a length of the A5 trunk road to the west of Llangollen, Denbighshire that is currently de-restricted to the national speed limit. Introducing a lower speed limit will reduce the speed of traffic approaching the town from the west and leaving the town heading westbound. It will create a buffer zone between the 60 mph and 30 mph speed limits to improve road safety for commuters and residents.

The A5 Trunk Road (Berwyn Road, Llangollen, Denbighshire) (De-Restriction) Order 2002 (S.I. 2002/1291 (W.128)) will be revoked by the proposed Order.

**THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (WEST OF
LLANGOLLEN, DENBIGHSHIRE) (40 MPH
SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202-**

The Welsh Ministers propose to make an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 84(1)(a), (2) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the length of the A5 trunk road that extends from a point 231 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the B5103 at Berwyn, west of Llangollen, Denbighshire to a point 1,537 metres east of the centre-point of that junction.

The introduction of the 40 mph speed limit is intended to improve road safety by creating a buffer zone between the length of the A5 trunk road which is currently subject to a 60 mph national speed limit and the 30 mph speed limit through the town of Llangollen.

The A5 Trunk Road (Berwyn Road, Llangollen, Denbighshire) (De-Restriction) Order 2002 (S.I. 2002/1291 (W. 128)) will be revoked by the proposed Order.
