ATISN 15058 - Request for Information

Thank you for your request which I received on 7 April 2021. You asked for the following information regarding land at Is Helen Farm, Caernarfon:

• 'I would like to know who previously attempted to claim for a holding number on our land, which they didn't own.'

Our response

I can confirm that Rural Payments Wales (RPW) received a Manage My CPH application which include land that forms part of your holding.

However, I am unable to provide the name of the claimant as I consider this the personal information of a private person and I have been unable to obtain consent to release the information. Therefore, I am withholding the information under Regulation 12 and 13 of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 as it unduly interferes with the right of the beneficiary to respect for their private life in general and to the protection of their personal data in particular.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
