Request for Information – ATISN 15156

I wrote to you on 24 May regarding your request for information.

Information requested

You asked for any information produced since the Senedd general election of 2011 which relates to the matters of:

- The costs and benefits of switching to metric speed limits and distance signs in Wales
- 2. How such a change could be effected
- 3. Whether such a change should be effected.

Our Response

I can confirm that the Welsh Government does not hold any information captured by your request. The form and character of traffic signs permitted on Britain's roads, including the units displayed, are prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. This is UK Government legislation and maintained by the Department for Transport.

Next steps
