I have many country skills including woodland management, hedge-laying, planting, fencing, landscaping which have all played a part in my work. I have specialised in cosmetic tree work, people don't notice quality tree surgery. A challenge I enjoy is restoring large overgrown gardens through judicial pruning and thinning. I write reports including environmental and ecological, bringing in specialists to advise where necessary.

Craft shows, chainsaw carving, exhibitions, sculpture.

I have attended many events as part of a collective, The Hardcore Carvers, doing workshops for adults and children and exhibiting work [1990's]. I have chainsaw carved at the first English Open Chainsaw Carving competition [2006], Woodfest Wales [2002-2008] and many events and shows. I have exhibited in art galleries, the National Botanical Gardens in Carmarthenshire and have a piece at the Greenwood Centre in North Wales. I also have work in private collections.
