## ATISN 15252 - Ice Rinks

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 18 June. You requested the following -

• The evidence regarding ice rink closures in Wales, specifically to athletes that need to train.

Since submitting your request, you will be pleased to know that a review has been undertaken, in consultation with rink operators and National Governing Bodies of ice sports in Wales. Given the assurances we received about the mitigations that will be put in place to minimise the risk of spreading coronavirus, Ministers have agreed that ice rinks can reopen from Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July, as we complete the move to alert level one in the Welsh Government's Coronavirus Control Plan.

We are aware that Ice Arena Wales is making preparations to reopen in a few weeks. You may wish to contact the facility directly to request an update.
