## ATISN 15275 – Bowel Cancer Screening

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 28 June regarding FIT Bowel Cancer Screening tests. You asked for:

- 1. The number of FIT Bowel Cancer Screening tests that have been carried out, for each of the past 3 years, in Wales.
- 2. The number of FIT test results that have triggered a follow up Bowel Cancer scan for each of the past 3 years Wales. Please also provide this figure as a percentage of total tests done.
- 3. The number of Bowel Cancer diagnoses that were the result of a FIT test being done. Please provide this for each of the past 3 years. Please provide these figures as a percentage of all FIT Tests.
