Thank you for your request which I received on 29 June 2021. You asked for the following information for 2020 through to the latest month of July 2021:

Actual covid deaths within all the main Welsh cities; and
Number of deaths from covid related issues within all the main Welsh cities

You further stated the information should be actual deaths from covid, meaning anyone who's died specifically from covid alone and had NO other ailments and Covid related deaths, meaning ANY death which has occurred from previous ailment sufferers in combination with covid-19.

I can confirm Welsh Government does not hold the information requested. The Office for National Statistics (ONS) collect and produce mortality statistics for England and Wales based on information collected from the death registration process. They publish [weekly](#) statistics on deaths involving Covid-19 (i.e. Covid-19 was mentioned on the death certificate as a contributory cause of death) by area and week. They also publish [monthly](#) statistics on deaths due to Covid-19 (i.e. where Covid-19 was identified as the underlying (main) cause on the death certificate), which are broken down by month and area (including local authorities such as Cardiff, Newport and Swansea).

The ONS have also [published](#) information on pre-existing conditions mentioned on the death certificate of deaths involving Covid-19. For further information on this data, please contact the ONS at health.data@ons.gov.uk
