## Request for Information – ATISN 15435

Thank you for your email dated 20 August.

## Information requested

You have asked how much it cost for the average speed camera between Junction 24 and Junction 28 cost to be installed that were fitted recently as per the recommendations of the study taken after the M4 relief road was scrapped.

You also asked how much did that study cost?

## Our response

I can confirm we hold the information relating to your request.

The installation costs of the ASE camera system project between M4 J24 and J28 was £1,444,474.59.

The cost of the South East Wales Transport Commission for the study, including Commissioner's time charge, expenses, data collection and other technical support was around £2.5m.(exc. VAT)
