## ATISN 15441 - Face Mask use

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 19 August. You asked for -

- Evidence used to support the current Welsh Government policy on face mask usage. Specifically, evidence that demonstrates why face masks are not required in a nightclub but must be worn in a shop

## Our response:

The scientific and technical evidence on the use of face coverings is available in the following documents published by the Technical Advisory Group and the Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies:

<u>Technical Advisory Group - Updated Advice on Face Coverings</u>
<u>Application of physical distancing and fabric face coverings in mitigating the B117 variant SARS-CoV-2 virus in public, workplace and community settings</u>

Whilst this scientific and technical evidence is available, it is used alongside a variety of other social and economic factors when the government considers and decides on policy.
