Complaint in respect of ATISN 15412

I am responding to your email which was received on 28 September 2021, complaining about our response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information ("FOI") Act 2000. This letter is to inform you of the outcome.

You had asked for the following information:

- Can you please provide me with the data you used to effectively continue with masks

On 09 September, we responded to your request and provided links towards documents published by the Technical Advisory Group and the Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies that outlined the rationale for the continued use of face masks.

I have reviewed our response to your FOI request in accordance with the procedure stated in my previous letter to you (dated 28 September). In this instance, I believe that our response was correct, and that the exemption applied was appropriate.

In the circumstances, I do not uphold your complaint.
