## ATISN 15526 – Neurodevelopmental Services

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 21 September. You requested the following -

• Broken down by Health Board, details of the level of funding provided for neurodevelopmental diagnostic and treatment services for each fiscal year since 2015-16.

## Response

In May 2015 we announced our investment of an extra £7.65m every year in mental health services for children and young people in Wales, which represented an 18% increase in funding.

£2m of this funding was to help develop neuro-developmental (ND) services, including ADHD and autistic spectrum disorders. Further details on this funding can be found in our announcement

This level of funding - £2m, is recurrent so funding has been provided at that level year on year and will continue into future years.
