Thank you for your request which I received on 23-Oct-2021. You asked for:

"Disclosure of the material relating to the Welsh Government's request to officers for a report on the available waste/recovered wood in the South Wales area. I believe this was under review in and/or about 2017 and will have been considered under the quidance of Jasper Roberts. No report has been published as far as I am aware.

Please ensure disclosure is made of the original terms requested for the report, copy draft reports including correspondence, emails, minutes of meetings with Ministers to give a full overview of the findings whether preliminary or final and the reasoning for non-publication to date."

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

However, data on the amount of wood waste produced in Wales is regularly published within broader reports on all waste types produced by different sectors, please see links to this information below:

Wood is long established as a recyclable material. Reprocessing firms sort and remove contaminants before shredding and screening waste wood to different sizes of end product, which are then dried and bagged prior to sale. The end product is wood chip, which is screened and sized according to the required end-use⁷, is typically summarised as:

- chipboard factories (heavy/course material for chipboard, MDF and plywood, packaging etc);
- · animal bedding (fine material);
- · community playgrounds (fine material); and
- · biomass power (pellets).
