

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A470
(FFORDD LLANRWST, LLANSANFFRAID
GLAN CONWY, CONWY) (TERFYN
CYFLYMDER 40 MYA) 2021**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn drwy arfer eu pwerau o dan adran 84(1)(a) a (2) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, sy'n dod i rym ar 23 Tachwedd 2021.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw cyflwyno terfyn cyflymder 40 mya ar y darn o'r A470 gefnffordd o'r enw Ffordd Llanwrst yn Llansanffraid Glan Conwy yn Sir Conwy sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 170 o fetrau i'r gogledd-orllewin o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Maes-y-Felin hyd at bwynt 385 o fetrau i'r de-ddwyrain o ganolbwynt y gyffordd honno.

Yn ystod cyfnod o 6 wythnos o 17 Tachwedd 2021 ymlaen, gellir edrych ar gopi o'r Hysbysiad hwn, y Gorchymyn a wnaed a'r plan yn ystod oriau agor arferol yng Nghyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy, Bodlondeb, Ffordd Bangor, Conwy, LL32 8DU.

**THE A470 TRUNK ROAD (LLANRWST ROAD,
LLANSANFFRAID GLAN CONWY, CONWY)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2021**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 23 November 2021.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the length of the A470 trunk road known as Llanwrst Road at Llansanffraid Glan Conwy in the County of Conwy that extends from a point 170 metres north-west of the centre-point of its junction with Maes-Y-Felin to a point 385 metres south-east of the centre-point of that junction.

During a period of 6 weeks from 17 November 2021 a copy of this Notice, the made Order and plan may be inspected during normal opening hours from Conwy County Borough Council, Bodlondeb, Bangor Road, Conwy, LL32 8DU.

Please note: Access to Conwy County Borough Council will be subject to the relevant COVID-19 restrictions in place at the time. Due to COVID-19 social distancing restrictions, inspections or collection of the documents will be by prior appointment only.
