Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 8 November 2021. You asked for:

Information regarding the number of CO₂ monitors that have been supplied to schools in Wales between 1 August 2021 and 8 November 2021, specifically;

- How many CO₂ monitors have been supplied in total in Wales?
- How many schools have received at least one CO₂ monitor with breakdown of secondary and primary schools?
- How many CO₂ monitors have been supplied to each county council area or health board area in Wales?

Our response

The information you requested is below;

- As of 8 November 3,221 CO₂ monitors had been supplied out of a total of 20,595 allocated to schools in Wales.
- Each local authority received an allocation from each delivery for local prioritisation, and therefore numbers of schools supplied by 8 November was not recorded by the Welsh Government.
- Allocations of CO₂ monitors per local authority are shown in the table overleaf;
