ATISN 15835 - Covid Description

Thank you for your enquiry to the Welsh Government received on 21 December 2021 relating to COVID-19.

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 (Fol Act) provides a right to request information that is held in a recorded format. From your email, your enquiry contains the following valid Fol request:

- 1. The raw track and trace data; and,
- 2. the clinical data for each of those patients who have died within 28 days of testing positive for COVID-19.

Our Response

Welsh Government does not hold the information you are requesting.

- Public Health Wales (PHW) may be able to assist and should you wish to submit a further Freedom of Information request to them, you can do so via the following channel: https://phw.nhs.wales/use-of-site/contact-us/freedom-of-information
- 2. The Office for National Statistics (ONS) collect and produce mortality statistics for England and Wales based on information from the death registration process. They publish weekly statistics on deaths involving Covid-19 (i.e. Covid-19 was mentioned on the death certificate as a contributory cause of death) and monthly statistics on deaths due to Covid-19 (i.e. where Covid-19 was identified as the underlying (main) cause on the death certificate).

The ONS also show the different pre-existing conditions of deaths due to Covid-19.
