The Paper sets out a number of alternative growth and spatial strategy options for the RLDP having regard to the Plan's evidence base and policy aspirations, and identifies what is currently the Council's preferred growth and spatial options that are considered to best address the County's key issues/challenges and meet the RLDP objectives. The current preference will be reviewed in the light of consultation responses.
