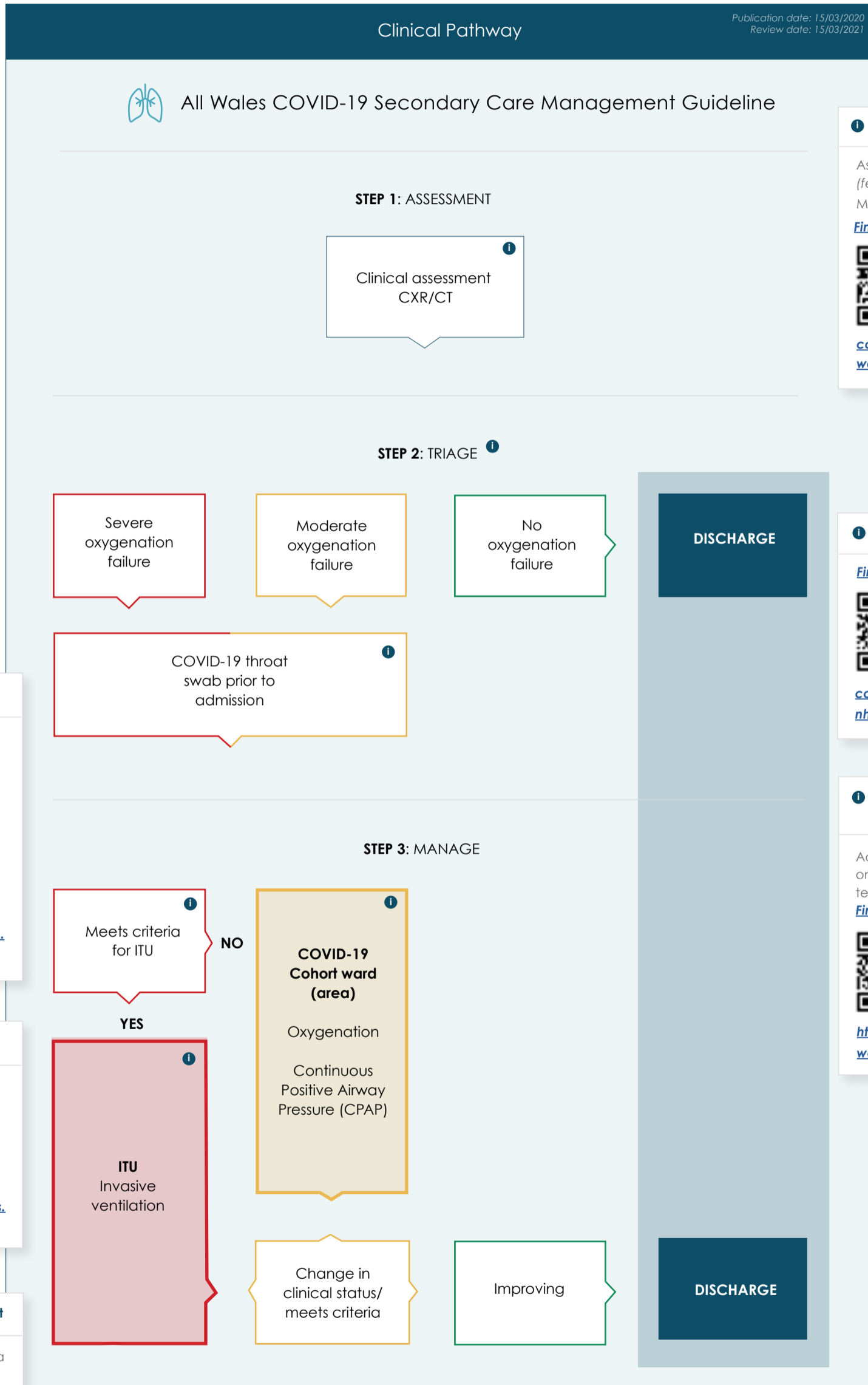




All Wales COVID-19 Secondary Care Management Guideline

STEP 1 INFORMATION: ASSESSMENT

Clinical assessment

Assess COVID-19 risk symptoms (fever, cough, dyspnoea)
Measure: SpO₂, RR, pulse, BP

COVID-19 Ward Management

1. Ward oxygen up to 15 litres via non-rebreathe mask
2. Administer fluids
3. Manage co-morbidities
4. Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP)
5. Thromboprophylaxis
