1. Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cau Prifffordd (69 – 70 Ffordd y Brenin, Abertawe) 2022 a daw i rym ar 8 Mawrth 2022.

Dehongli

2. Yn y Gorchymyn hwn—

ystyr “y Cyngor” (“*the Council*”) yw Cyngor Dinas a Sir Abertawe;

ystyr “y datblygwr” (“*the developer*”) yw'r person sy'n gwneud y datblygiad y mae'r caniatâd cynllunio wedi ei roi ar ei gyfer;

ystyr “Deddf 1990” (“*the 1990 Act*”) yw Deddf Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1990; ac

ystyr “y plan a adnewwyd” (“*the deposited plan*”) yw'r plan sy'n dwyn yr enw “Gorchymyn Cau Prifffordd (69 – 70 Ffordd y Brenin, Abertawe) 2022” sy'n dod gyda'r Gorchymyn hwn.

Cau Prifffordd

3. Yn ddarostyngedig i erthyglau 4 a 5 o'r Gorchymyn hwn, mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn awdurdodi cau'r darnau o brifffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Gorchymyn hwn ac a ddangosir â llinellau sebra ar y plan a adnewwyd. Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi eu bodloni bod angen cau'r brifffordd er mwyn gwneud y datblygiad yn unol â'r caniatâd cynllunio a roddwyd o dan Ran 3 o Ddeddf 1990 gan y Cyngor ar 3 Awst 2020 o dan y cyfeirnod 2020/1437/FUL, ac a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (69 – 70 THE KINGSWAY, SWANSEA) ORDER 2022

Made 3 March 2022

Coming into force 8 March 2022

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of their powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990(1), make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. The title of this Order is the Stopping Up of Highways (69 – 70 The Kingsway, Swansea) Order 2022 and it comes into force on 8 March 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the Council” (“*y Cyngor*”) means the Council of the City and County of Swansea;

“the deposited plan” (“*y plan a adnewwyd*”) means the plan entitled “The Stopping Up of Highways (69 – 70 The Kingsway, Swansea) Order 2022” which accompanies this Order;

“the developer” (“*y datblygwr*”) means the person carrying out the development for which the planning permission has been granted; and

“the 1990 Act” (“*Deddf 1990*”) means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Stopping Up

3. Subject to articles 4 and 5 of this Order the Welsh Ministers authorise the stopping up of the lengths of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order and shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan. The Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the stopping up is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permissions granted under Part 3 of the 1990 Act by the Council on 3 August 2020 with reference 2020/1437/FUL and described in Schedule 2 to this Order.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

Y Darpariaethau sy'n Angenrheidiol neu'n Hwylus cyn Cau Priffordd

4. Ni chaniateir cau'r darnau o briffordd a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Gorchymyn hwn—

- (a) hyd nes y bydd y datblygwr wedi darparu, er boddhad rhesymol y Cyngor, blaniau sy'n dangos sut y mae'r darnau o briffordd i'w cau;
- (b) hyd nes y bydd y datblygiad a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn wedi ei ddechrau a bod y datblygwr wedi hysbysu'r Cyngor yn ysgrifenedig ei bod yn angenrheidiol cau'r briffordd er mwyn i'r datblygiad fynd rhagddo; ac
- (c) hyd nes y bydd y Cyngor wedi ysgrifennu at y datblygwr i gadarnhau bod paragraffau (a) a (b) wedi eu bodloni.

Ymgymrwyr Statudol a Darparwyr

5. Pan fo gan ymgymrwyr statudol neu ddarparwyr system gyfathrebu gyhoeddus unrhyw gyfarpar o dan y briffordd, ynddi, arni, drosti, ar ei hyd neu ar ei thraws yn union cyn cau'r darnau o briffordd yna (yn ddarostyngedig i adran 261(4) o Ddeddf 1990), bydd gan yr ymgymrwyr neu'r darparwyr yr un hawliau mewn cysylltiad â'r cyfarpar ag a oedd ganddynt cyn cau'r briffordd.

Provisions Necessary or Expedient before Stopping Up

4. The lengths of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order must not be stopped up until—

- (a) the developer has provided, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council, plans showing how the lengths of highway are to be stopped up;
- (b) the development described in Schedule 2 to this Order has commenced and the developer has informed the Council in writing of the necessity to stop up the highway to allow the development to proceed; and
- (c) the Council has confirmed in writing to the developer that paragraphs (a) and (b) are satisfied.

Statutory Undertakers and Providers

5. Where immediately before the lengths of highway are stopped up, there is under, in, on, over, along or across the highway any apparatus of statutory undertakers or public communications providers then (subject to section 261(4) of the 1990 Act) the undertakers or providers continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they had before the stopping up.

Darn petryalog ei siâp o briffordd, sy'n mesur tua 6.68 metr sgwâr, o flaen yr eiddo o'r enw 69 a 70 Ffordd y Brenin, Abertawe, y rhoddir iddo'r cyfeirnod 'A' ac a ddangosir â llinellau sebra ar y plan a adnewwyd.

Darn petryalog ei siâp o briffordd, sy'n mesur tua 12.311 o fetrau sgwâr, i'r gorllewin o'r eiddo o'r enw 70 Ffordd y Brenin, ar Picton Lane, Abertawe, y rhoddir iddo'r cyfeirnod 'B' ac a ddangosir â llinellau sebra ar y plan a adnewwyd.

Darn afreolaidd ei siâp o briffordd, sy'n mesur tua 14.895 o fetrau sgwâr, y tu cefn i'r eiddo o'r enw 69 a 70 Ffordd y Brenin, ar Picton Lane, Abertawe, y rhoddir iddo'r cyfeirnod 'C' ac a ddangosir â llinellau sebra ar y plan a adnewwyd.

ATODLEN 2

Y Datblygiad

Newid defnydd hen fanc (dosbarthau A2 / B1) i ddefnydd masnachol cymysg ar y llawr daear (dosbarthau A1 / A2 / A3) a defnydd busnes (dosbarth B1) ar y llawr cyntaf a'r ail lawr gyda gwaith ailwampio allanol yn cynnwys gosod cladin newydd ar furiau'r adeilad ac ychwanegu dwy fynedfa ar y llawr daear ym mlaen (gogledd) ac yng nghefn (de) yr adeilad.

SCHEDULE 1
(All measurements are approximate)

Lengths of highway to be stopped up

A rectangular shaped length of highway measuring approximately 6.68 square metres, located in front of the properties known as 69 & 70 The Kingsway, Swansea, given the reference 'A' and shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan.

A rectangular shaped length of highway measuring approximately 12.311 square metres, located to the west of the property known as 70 The Kingsway, on Picton Lane Swansea, given the reference 'B' and shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan.

An irregular shaped length of highway measuring approximately 14.895 square metres, located to the rear of the properties known as 69 & 70 The Kingsway, on Picton Lane, Swansea, given the reference 'C' and shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan.

SCHEDULE 2

The Development

The change of use of a former bank (classes A2 / B1) to a mixed commercial use on the ground floor (classes A1 / A2 / A3) and business use (class B1) on the first and second floors with external refurbishment including the recladding of the elevations and the addition of two ground floor accesses on the front (north) and rear (south) elevations.
