Vehicle details:	V1,Vauxhall Astra Sri CDTi 5 door saloon V2, Audi A6 SE Quattro TDi Estate V3, Vauxhall Corsa 5 door
Damage to road furniture:	Damage to tree base at nearside of road.
Brief description of incident:	V1 and V3 travelling towards Bow Street with V2 travelling in opposite direction. V1 has come into contact with the nearside hedge following travelling around a right hand bend. Having mounted the hedge, V1 collided heavily with a mature tree, causing it to rotate anticlockwise and fall back on to the road surface, coming into contact with V2. V3 has passed through the scene and stopped, with V2 rolling backwards post collision and colliding with the rear of V3.
Any Highway implications, including contributory factors(debris in carriageway/ standing water etc):	None known or alleged. No skid testing done at the scene due to the surface being heavily contaminated with engine oil from the Vauxhall Astra
