Dear Adam,

Thank you for your letter of 14 October regarding the proposed A483 Llandeilo bypass.

As you know, the Llandeilo by-pass was part of budget agreements made between Plaid Cymru and the Welsh Labour Government in the previous Senedd and as such, does not form part of the Welsh Government's Road Review.

However, we need fewer cars on our roads, more people using public transport and more walking or cycling as part of our efforts to reach our NetZero climate change targets. My officials are currently considering the range of views expressed by the public and the Independent Review Panel in order to present proposals that could secure consensus amongst key stakeholders and allow the work to progress to WeITAG Stage 3, where residents would be able to contribute their views on those proposals.
