

GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A483 (Y STRAND, LLANFAIR-YM-MUALLT, POWYS) (GWAHARDD CERBYDAU DROS DRO) 2022

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A483, neu gerllaw iddi, ar Y Strand yn Llanfair-ym-Muallt yn Sir Powys.

Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys ac ar gyfer y gwaith, rhag mynd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A483 o'r enw Y Strand sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 5 metr i'r dwyrain o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Heol y Gogledd hyd at bwynt 5 metr i'r gorllewin o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Strand Street yn Llanfair-ym-Muallt, Powys.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer traffig sy'n teithio tua'r dwyrain y bydd cau'r ffordd yn effeithio arno yw mynd ar yr A483 tua'r gorllewin i Beulah, ar y B4358 tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain i'r Bontnewydd-ar-Wy, ac yna ar yr A470 tua'r de i Lanfair-ym-Muallt. Nid effeithir ar draffig sy'n teithio tua'r gorllewin.

Bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro, y codir arwyddion priodol yn ei gylch, yn weithredol rhwng 19:00 o'r gloch ar 24 Mehefin 2022 a 18:00 o'r gloch ar 26 Mehefin 2022 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod yr amseroedd a'r dyddiadau a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (THE STRAND, BUILTH WELLS, POWYS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITIONS OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2022

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A483 trunk road on The Strand at Builth Wells in the County of Powys.

The effect of the Order will be to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services and for the works, from proceeding on the length of the A483 trunk road known as The Strand that extends from a point 5 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with North Road to a point 5 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Strand Street at Builth Wells, Powys.

The alternative route for eastbound traffic affected by the closure will be via the A483 westbound to Beulah, the B4358 north-eastbound to Newbridge-on-Wye, then the A470 southbound to Builth Wells. Westbound traffic will be unaffected.

The temporary prohibition, which will be signed accordingly, will operate from 19:00 hours on 24 June 2022 until 18:00 hours on 26 June 2022 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the proposed Order is only expected to operate during the times and dates specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months as a contingency should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Advance notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work.
