

**GORCHYMYN Y B5125 (CHESTER ROAD),
(BRYCHDYN, SIR Y FFLINT) (TERFYN
CYFLYMDER 40 MYA) 2022**

**THE B5125 (CHESTER ROAD), (BROUGHTON,
FLINTSHIRE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER
2022**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 3 February 2022.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the length of the B5125 Chester Road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of the A5104 Airbus Roundabout in a south easterly direction for a distance of 461 metres.

During a period of 6 weeks from 2 February 2022 a copy of the Order together with a Plan, may be inspected free of charge, during normal opening hours at:
