Thank you for your request which I received on 9 June 2022. You asked for the following information:

Records of two public enquiries:-

- 1. The Inspector's decision following a Public Enquiry into the proposal for the erection of a turkey-rearing shed at Gilestone Farm, Talybont-on-Usk. I believe the enquiry, held in Henderson Hall, Talybont-on-Usk, took place in 1988 or 1989. This would have been under the Welsh Office.
- 2. The Inspector's decision following a Public Enquiry into the proposal to designate areas around Talybont-on-Usk for the future extraction of Sand and Gravel. This was to be inserted into the UDP or LDP then under consideration. It followed the publication of the Symonds Report 2000. The enquiry was held in the offices of the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority, to the best of my recollection in 2003/2004. This was under the Welsh Assembly Government.

We do not hold a copy of the decision for a turkey rearing shed at Gilestone Farm, TalyBont-on-Usk. Decisions are only held for 5 years from the date of decision, or the last significant action taken in the case, in light of a high court challenge. Local planning authorities have a duty to maintain a public planning register. Appeal decisions are held by them in line with this duty.

We do not hold a copy of the Inspectors report for the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority (BBNPA) Unitary Development Plan (UDP). BBNPA Local Development Plan (LDP) was adopted by the National Park Authority on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2013. A copy of the Inspectors report is attached.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
