



Following the farm walk at the land at millin (Rhos 1) on the 15<sup>th</sup> of February 2022, the 9 acre field know as 1 Millin. Had a population of ryegrass, cocksfoot, timothy to indicate a productive grass lay. along with these productive grasses there was high density of soft rush.

The soil was a clay loam and becoming more of a clay at the bottom of the slope, the clay content impeded water flow giving favourable conditions for rush.

The soil results for 1 Millin (Rhos 1) are below, as can be seen the field was used in the grazing platform prior to being sold. The soils are low in phosphate and moderately low potash.
