**ATISN 16513 – M4 Temporary Speed Limit**

Thank you for your request which I received on 27 July 2022. You asked for:

Information regarding The M4 motorway (junction 45 (Ynysforgan) to junction 46 (Llangyfelach), Swansea) (temporary 50mph speed limit) Order 2022 which came into force 12 June 2022.

1. In what newspaper(s) and what date(s) the notice of intention was published.
2. In what newspaper(s) and what date(s) the notice of the making of the order was published
3. Which edition of the London Gazette contained the prior notice of intention
4. The consultation response of the chief officer of police
5. Which organisations representing road users were consulted, and their responses

**Our response**

1. In what newspaper(s) and what date(s) the notice of intention was published.

Our response: South Wales Evening Post on 25th May 2022.

2. In what newspaper(s) and what date(s) the notice of the making of the order was published

Our response: South Wales Evening Post on 10th June 2022.

3. Which edition of the London Gazette contained the prior notice of intention.

Our response: The Order referred is a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO). A notice is not placed in the London Gazette for TTROs.

4. The consultation response of the chief officer of police.

Our response: No information is held. Where a TTRO is made under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, there is no legal requirement to consult the Police before making the order.

5. Which organisations representing road users was consulted, and their responses

Our response: No information is held. Where a TTRO is made under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, there is no legal requirement to consult road users or their representative bodies before making the order.
