- Figures on the uptake numbers in Wales for the universal service obligation (USO) in total and over the last year
- How many people used the USO scheme (in total and over the last year)
- How many Welsh individuals/businesses had to contribute their own funds to top up the £3,400 covered by the scheme (in total and over the last year)
- How much did the average user of the scheme in Wales have to contribute (in total and over the last year)

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government. The USO scheme is a UK Government initiative being overseen by Ofcom and as such the Welsh Government does not hold this information.
