Strategic action 2. Increase the opportunities for learners to experience languages alongside examination courses

- Despite the current circumstances and the newest restrictions, the learning continuity has been guaranteed by sending resources and online lessons to be uploaded in the school google classrooms. In the school year 2020/21, students who are attending weekly Italian lessons are about 180, in primary schools, and about 40, in secondary schools.

- At the beginning of last year our office contacted several schools in Wales, but only those who had already joined our programme answered.

- The recently published Italian Curriculum focuses on the learning continuum of the student, from KS1 to A-Level. - The Italian Education Department Published on its website the Italian MLF Syllabus, drawn up in a horizontal vision, from EYFS to Year 6, and vertical for each class, declining it in the various Term.

The "Core" and the "Cross" contents, as well as the "Grammar Focus" are differenciated for each year from those that later become "transversal" in the higher classes.
